The Aircraft Survival Kit bag has a handle which allows it to be carried like a suitcase, as well as stowable/concealed shoulder straps which allow it to be worn as a backpack. The kit contains the basic survival essentials, and is easily modified to end-user specific requirements.

The installation of an **ECONOMICAL, LIGHT-WEIGHT and COMPACT** emergency survival kit provides essential survival aids in the event of an over-land ditching.

## CREW SURVIVAL SYSTEM (CSS)

Weighing only 23 lbs., the Crew Survival System (CSS) is a two-person, 48 Hours Modular Survival ruck with "Bug Out Bag" functionality designed to replace Legacy Aircrew Survival Kits weighing over 80 lbs. The bag and contents were thoroughly reviewed for efficiency and effectiveness: splitting the kits into three modules enables ALSE shop personnel ease of management. Using a combination of US MIL-SPEC, NSN and modern upgraded survival aids and MATBOCK's Emergency Medical Aviator Bag (EMAB), we were significantly able to reduce weight and bulk while also protecting the contents of the bag from aircraft fluid damage.
